

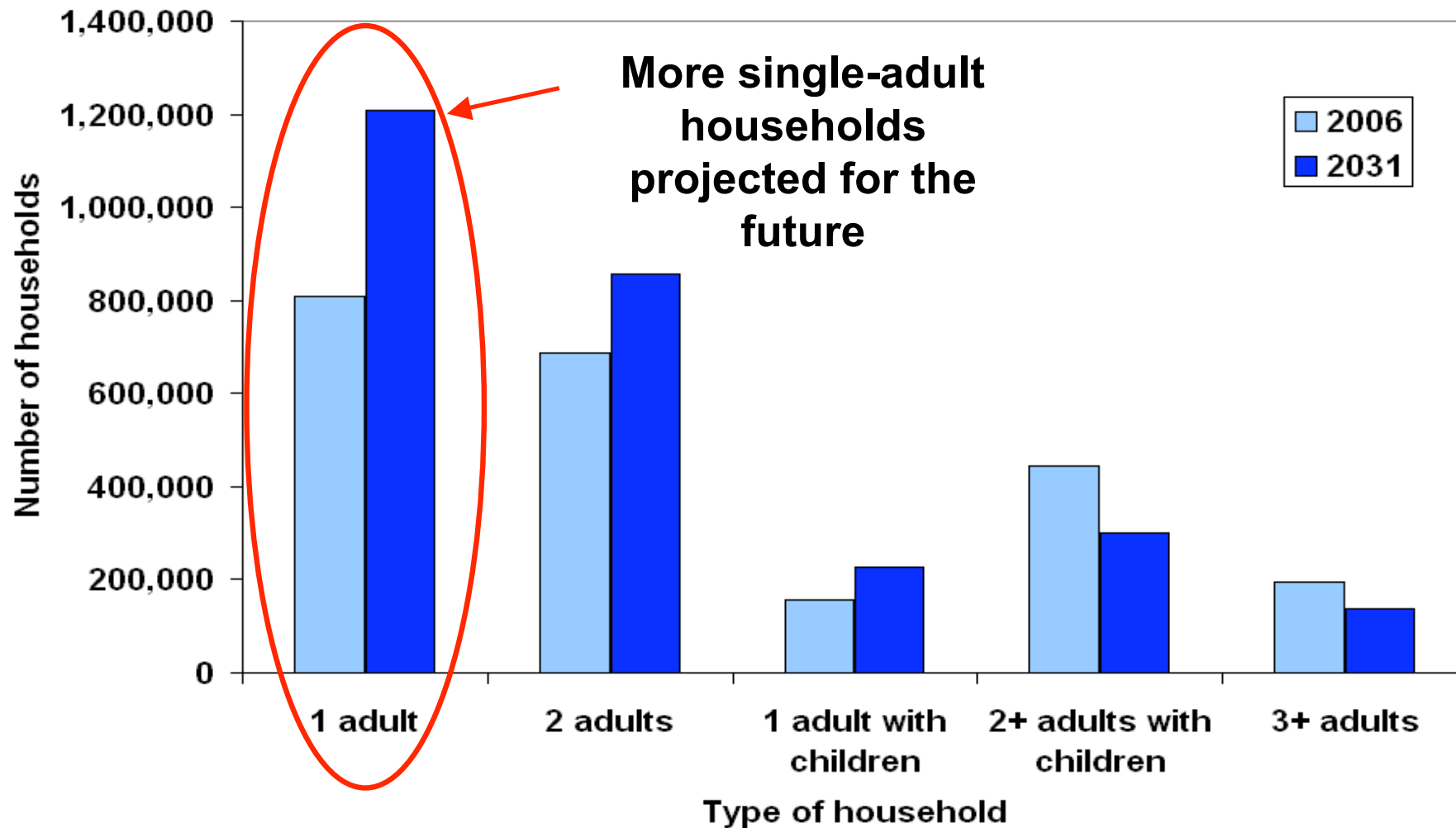

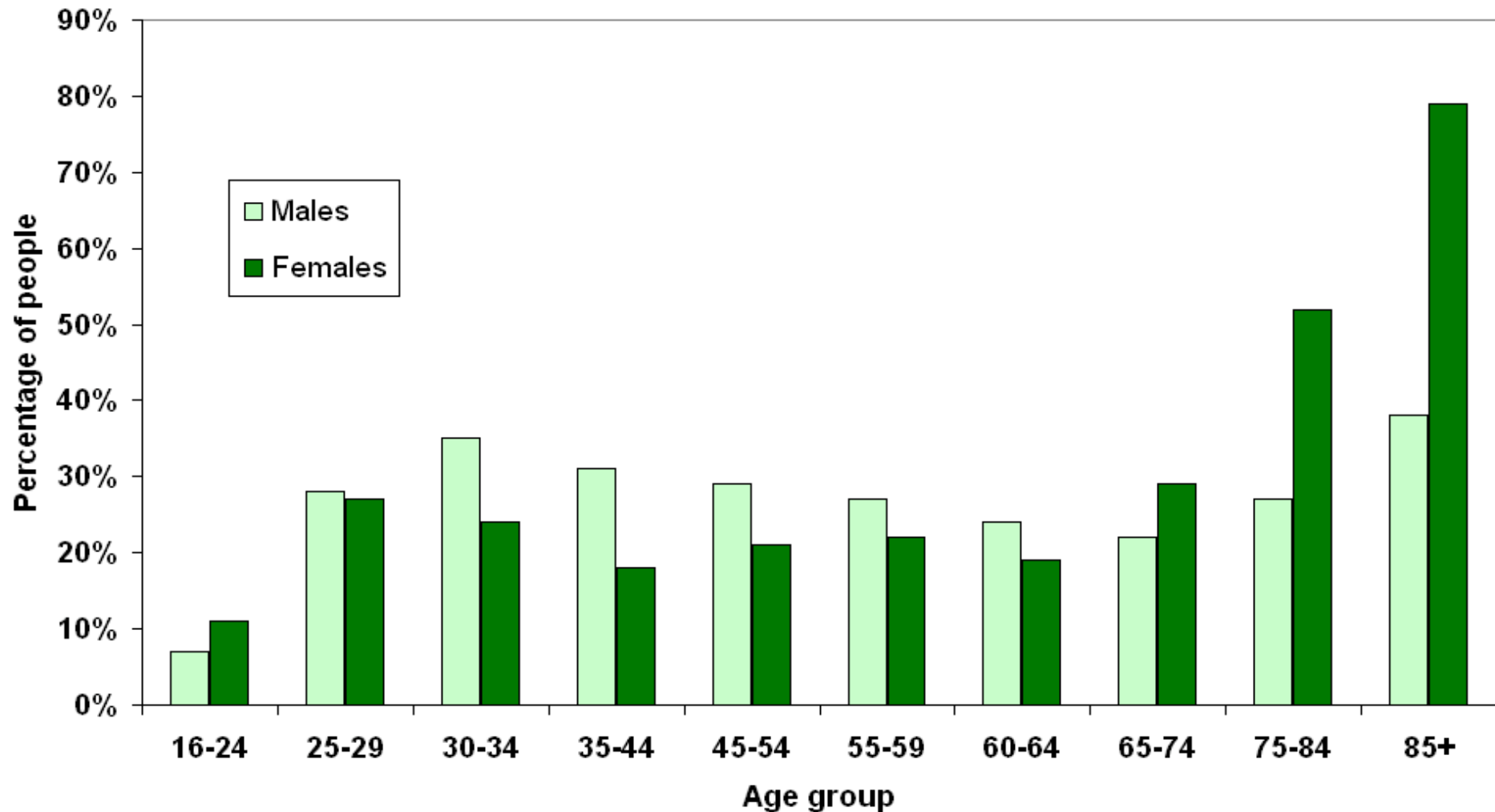

Projected proportions of people living alone, 2031

- A projected 50% increase in single-adult households between 2006 and 2031
- 44% of households projected to be single-adult in 2031
- Highest proportion of solo-living in cities: Glasgow City, Aberdeen City
- Lowest in Aberdeenshire, East Renfrewshire
