### Aim

Implement a systemic approach and study the impact if any on both families and practitioners.

### Family Findings

Professional system should work more collectively.

Child's Planning meetings need to centre on the family rather than being solely education focused.

The child should be included in their own meetings in school.

### Practitioner Findings

Focused on the people rather than problems.

Allows different relationship with the family.

Big picture is seen and used.

Calmer more respectful way of working.

More aware of the needs of the needs of the whole family.

Celebrate what is going well.

Shifts your mindset to focus on strengths.

Enables reflective practice.

Improved awareness of different cultures.

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Improved quality of listening.

### Conclusion

Given time, this approach may yield improvements in the relationship between the practitioner and client, creating a basis from which to effect change.
